- ○ ○ ○ Pitfichie Forest Trail - 15km 3-5 hours  
Gradient: Moderate with some steep sections which may have to be walked.  
Surface: Mostly on Forest Road with about 10% on rough track.  
Suitable for: Good mountain bikers with good views of Bennachie and Vale of Alford. Trail also suitable for walkers and horse riders.
- ▲ ▲ ▲ ▲ Cairn William Trail - 7km - sections off white trail  
Gradient: Steep  
Surface: Width below 1m with a wide range of surfaces including very rocky.  
Please ride in the direction of the arrows.  
Suitable for: Good mountain bikers. Amazing views of summit ridge with berms and stone staircase.
- — — — Pitfichie Downhill Trails - 1.2km - Downhill  
Gradient: Steep with drop offs.  
Surface: Mostly rough narrow tracks with jumps and drop offs.  
Suitable for: Expert downhill mountain bikers. Not suitable for walkers or horse riders.
